Session Descriptions

Saturday, 9:45 - Wonderfully Made: The Christian Worldview and Sexuality*

We benefit when they can discuss with confidence human sexuality from the perspective of a Christian world view as opposed to the culture's toxic representation of sex. This session explores biblical teachings on sexuality, God's design for sex within the context of marriage, the importance of chastity and respect for one's own body, the sanctity of sex in marriage. The role of forgiveness, grace and healthy boundaries is underscored.

Saturday, 11:15 - GPS Essentials for Difficult Conversations in Classroom, Home, and Church*

Maintaining relationships throughout conversational minefields is a challenge faced by pastors, teachers & parents. Unfortunately, we don't always navigate our way through these conversations in the most helpful ways. This presentation carefully looks at the anatomy of such conversations, outlines personal strategies for maintaining control and respect while reducing anxieties to achieve the best possible outcomes for all.

Saturday, 1:30 - Mental Health and the Church*

How can the church and school respond to specific mental health issues – anxiety, depression, related behavioral issues - that are becoming more prevalent? Beginning with an engaging PowerPoint presentation, clinical and spiritually informed action plans to take home and implement with confidence.

Saturday, 3:00 A - Light in the Darkness: Christian Responses to Conflict in a Sexually Toxic Culture

Unhealthy sexual behaviors promoted and popularized in our culture cause polarization and conflict in our hearts and homes. It's essential to manage conflict with wisdom, confidence & patience. More importantly, we need to look beneath the surface to see the spiritual issues that are involved in this battle. As Christians, we need to insure we remain grounded in the judgment and mercies of Christ.

Saturday, 3:00 B - Caring for the Child who Identifies as Transgender: Understanding the Big Picture*

This topic reviews competing perspectives & recommendations in caring for transgender children. Candid views on biology, gender dysphoria, myths/realities are offered as we examine what care/despair looks like for child, parent, school and church. Highly recommended for all who love children.

Friday, 1:00 - Pastoral Care for Those Who Cohabit

Every pastor is challenged by couples who cohabit. Often viewed as a private matter for the couples involved, cohabitation in reality burdens consciences of parents, grandparents, & church members, as well as the pastor. This session emphasizes the need to confront worldly values with the Christian invitation to a "more excellent way".

Friday, 3:30 - Pastoral Support for Families of LGBT Children

The need to support families of LGBTQ+ children is become increasingly clear to pastors. This presentation explores how pastors and parishes may be able to become places of refuge and support for family members, and includes resources that have been used effectively to support family members.

Friday, 2:15 - Making Referrals with Confidence

This session focuses on useful tools to help pastors and teachers determine when circumstances call for referral. When are referrals appropriate? By whom, and under what circumstances? How will referrals be received? .What about issues involving gender dysphoria and transgenderism? Useful strategies that address these questions are provided.

Presenters

Rev. David Fleming is DOXOLOGY's Executive Director for Spiritual Care. A 1986 graduate of Concordia Theological Seminary, Ft. Wayne, IN, he served as Senior Pastor at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Grand Rapids from 1993-2019 and currently, as part time Associate Pastor. He is a member of the Concordia University Wisconsin Board of Regents. an often-requested presenter for district and regional conferences, and has served missionaries and pastors throughout the US and the world. He has authored a variety of articles and the Concordia Publishing House Advent resource, "God Loves me Dearly." Fleming and his wife, Jo Marie, are blessed with three children and several grandchildren.

Dr. Beverly K. Yahnke is a clinical psychologist serving as the Executive Director of Christian Counsel for DOXOLOGY and on the Board of Regents of Concordia Theological Seminary, Ft. Wayne, IN.

During her 25 years in private clinical practice, she provided care for church workers and their families. She has also served as Department Chair and Professor of Psychology at Concordia University Wisconsin where she was named "Faculty Laureate". Her work with DOXOLOGY has focused on providing pastors, teachers, and church workers with opportunities for renewal and advanced training. Dr. Yahnke has written numerous articles about psychology, education, and faith. cator. conferences. She also serves on the Board of Regents of Concordia Theological Seminary in Ft. Wayne, Indiana.
